

Setting up your Axolotl Tank

Washing Sand

Before placing sand in your axolotl aquarium place the sand in a bucket and place a garden hose in their to rinse the sand until the water coming off the sand is clear. This should take approx. 3-4 minutes.



Setting up the Aquarium

Step 1 – Place the washed sand in the bottom of the aquarium. Evenly spread the sand across the bottom of the aquarium.



Step 2 – Slowly fill the aquarium with tap water.



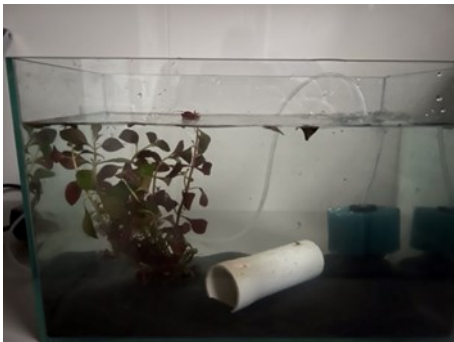

Step 3 – Place a plant into the sand, this can be anchored with some lead. You can include a pipe or something similar for your axolotl to hide in.



Step 4 – Place an air operated or low flow filter in the corner of your aquarium. Axolotls do not like strong currents. Let your aquarium age and settle for a week before introducing your axolotl.



Step 5 – Once you purchase your axolotl it is important to float your axolotl in the aquarium for approx. 45 minutes. This will allow enough time for the water to be the same temperature.

Step 6 – Your axolotl is now happy living in their new home.



Feeding

We recommend frozen bloodworms once a day or if you see uneaten food, you can feed every second day you can also feed live earth worms which are normally a nice treat or snack.
